**Please register by contacting one of the committee members by February 18.**

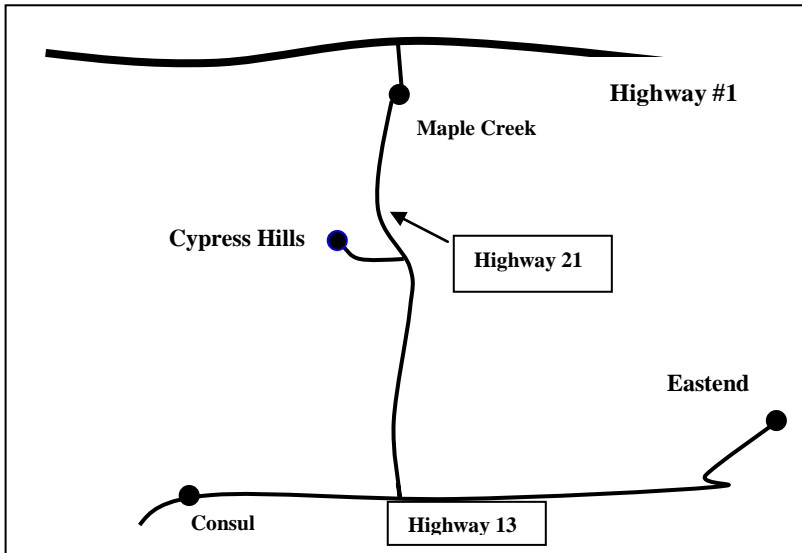
